

## COVID-19 Update 9/2/2020

Nexus Health Systems has been following the developments surrounding COVID-19 rates and its global impact. As a provider of healthcare, we are concerned with the health of our patients, our employees, and the community. CDC recommendations related to actions that we should take and sanctions for protecting those that we serve is evolving.

With the help of CDC guidance, we have implemented several plans that are designed to reduce the risk and incidence of COVID-19 in our facilities:

- Patient symptom screening upon admission and daily while an inpatient
- Employee health screening with any upper respiratory symptoms or travel history
- Employee temperature screening when reporting for work each day

### Visitation Policy Update

Nexus Neurorecovery Center has obtained authorization to begin Phase 1 visitations. These visits are outdoor only at this time and must be scheduled.

### Visiting Hours

Weekday Visitation: 3-7 p.m.

Weekend Visitation: 10-3 p.m.

- Patient's code needs to be provided prior to making reservation for visits and upon entering for visitation which they've received upon admission.
- Visits are in 30-minute increments; remember time flies when you're having fun, so staff needs to be mindful of the time.
- No more than three visitors at a time.
- The designated area will be the covered area between Churchill and Genesis.
- Staff will be available to transfer to and from the house
- Hand sanitizer will be available at the visiting area.
- All visitors need to wear a mask that covers the mouth and nose throughout the visit.
- Area needs to be sanitized between every visit.
- One visit per day.
- Visitors must sign in and out at the guard shack.
